November 27—Advent I—Matthew 24:44

You must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour.

December 4—Advent II—Matthew 3:11

John baptized with water for repentance, but one who is more powerful is coming; he will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire.

December 11—Advent III—Matthew 11:5

The blind receive their sight, the lame will walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them.

December 18—Advent IV—Matthew 1:23

The virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means “God is with us.”

December 25—Christmas Day—John 1:14

The Word became flesh and lived among us and we have seen his glory, the glory as of the Father’s only Son, full of grace and truth.

January 1—Name of Jesus—Luke 2:21

...He was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

January 6—Epiphany of Our Lord—Matthew 2:11

The wise men saw the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage. Then they offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

January 8—Baptism of our Lord—Matthew 3:17

A voice said from heaven, “This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased.”

January 15—Epiphany II—John 1:32, 34

John testified, “I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him...I myself seen and have testified that this is the Son of God.”

January 22—Epiphany III—Matthew 4:23

Jesus went through Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom.

January 29—Epiphany IV—Matthew 5: 3

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

February 2—Presentation of Our Lord—Luke 2:34b, 35b

The child is destined...to be a sign that will be opposed so that the inner thoughts of many will be revealed.

February 6---Epiphany V---Matthew 5:14, 16

You are the light of the world...Let your light so shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

February 13—Epiphany VI—Matthew 5:23f

When you are offering your gift at the altar, if you remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother and sister, and then come offer your gift.

February 20—Transfiguration of Our Lord—Matthew 17:5

This is my Son, the beloved; Listen to him!

February 22—Ash Wednesday—Matthew 6:4, 6, 18

Let your alms be done in secret...pray to your Father in Secret...let your fasting be seen by your Father in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

February 26—Lent I—Matthew 4:1

Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

March 5—Lent II—John 3:3

Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born anew.

March 12—Lent III—John 4:13

Those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty.

March 19—Lent IV—John 9:11

(He) said to me, “Go to Siloam and wash.” Then I went and washed and received my sight.

March 25—Annunciation of Our Lord—Luke 1:28, 42

Hail, Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with you. Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

March 26—Lent V—John 11:25

I am the resurrection and the life.

April 2—Sunday of the Passion—Matthew 27:51f

The earth shook, and the rocks were split. The tombs also were opened, and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised.

April 6—Maundy Thursday—John 13:34

I give you this commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another.

April 7—Good Friday—John 19: 34, 36

One of the soldiers pierced Jesus’ side with a spear, and at once blood and water came out. These things occurred so that the scripture might be fulfilled.

April 9—Easter Day—John 20:17

I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.

April 16—Easter II—John 20:31

These signs are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

April 23—Easter III—Luke 24:35

Then they told how Jesus had been made known to them in the breaking of bread.

April 30—Easter IV—John 10:9f

I am the gate; whoever enters by me will be saved.

May 7—Easter V—John 14:13

I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

May 14—Easter VI—John 14:16

I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you forever

May 18—Ascension of Our Lord—Luke 24:46b

...repentance for the forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations.

May 21—Easter VII—John 17:3

This is eternal life, that all may know you.

May 28—Day of Pentecost—John 14:26

The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

May 31---The Visitation---Luke 1: 42
