December 1—Advent I—Matthew 24:44

You must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour.

December 8—Advent II—Matthew 3:11

John baptized with water for repentance, but one who is more powerful is coming; he will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire.

December 15—Advent III—Matthew 11:5

The blind receive their sight, the lame will walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them.

December 22—Advent IV—Matthew 1:23

The virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means "God is with us."

December 25—Christmas Day—John 1:14

The Word became flesh and lived among us and we have seen his glory, the glory as of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth.

December 29—Christmas 1—Matthew 2:15, 23

This was to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophets, "Out of Egypt I have called my son" and "he will be called a Nazarene."

January 5---Christmas II---John 1:18

No one has ever seen God. It is God the only Son, who is close to the Father's heart, who has made him known.

January 6—Epiphany of Our Lord—Matthew 2:11

The wise men saw the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage. Then they offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

January 12—Epiphany I/ Baptism of our Lord—Matthew 3:17

A voice said from heaven, "This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased."

January 19—Epiphany II—John 1:32, 34

John testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him...I myself seen and have testified that this is the Son of God."

January 26—Epiphany III—Matthew 4:23

Jesus went through Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom.

February 2—Presentation of Our Lord—Luke 2:34b, 35b

The child is destined...to be a sign that will be opposed so that the inner thoughts of many will be revealed.

February 9—Epiphany V—Matthew 5:14, 16

You are the light of the world...Let your light so shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

February 16—Epiphany VI—Matthew 5:23f

When you are offering your gift at the altar, if you remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother and sister, and then come offer your gift.

February 23—Epiphany VIII/Trans. of Our Lord—Matthew 17:5

This is my Son, the beloved; Listen to him!

Let your alms be done in secret...pray to your Father in Secret...let your fasting be seen by your Father in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.
