25th Anniversary General Chapter Retreat ~ September 20-22, 2022
“Evangelical Catholicism in the Rule of the Society of the Holy Trinity.”

Place: The Conference Center of the University of St. Mary of the Lake/Mundelein Seminary, 1000 East Maple Avenue, Mundelein, Illinois 60060. Phone: (847) 566-8290.

Teaching Theologians and Banquet Speaker: Lecturing Tuesday night and Wednesday morning are The Rev'd Dr. John Baldovin SJ, Boston College; Dr. Melanie Ross, Yale University; and The Rev'd Dr. Kent Burreson, Concordia Seminary St. Louis. The Rev'd Dr. Richard Johnson STS will deliver an address after the anniversary banquet on Wednesday evening.

Times: Arrive Tuesday in time to check in for lunch at 1:00 pm. Concludes on Thursday with a bag lunch at 1:00 pm.

Monday arrivals: For those who wish to arrive on Monday, the extra charge is \$70 for overnight lodging. Meals on campus are available, if desired: Monday evening supper for \$16; Tuesday morning breakfast for \$12. Members must make reservations for early arrival in advance through your Dean. Payment for rooms/meals for both member and non-member early arrivals must be made in advance of arrival on campus. Send payment to the Secretary at the address below.

Deadline to Register: August 26, 2022. Cancellations are unable to be accepted after September 2, 2022.

Costs: Members of the Society pay for their participation in the General Retreat when they remit their annual dues. For *non*-members and guests, the cost of the retreat (including lodging and meals) is \$245 - shared room and \$265 - single room.

How to register: Members of the Society register through their Deans. *Non*-members of the Society use form below.

For those who are driving: NB: The main entrance to the seminary off of Route 176 is closed. Please enter campus from Route 45 (*Lake Street*). This entrance is just north of the Route 176/Route 45 intersection. In your GPS, enter “Route 45 and Dunbar/University Mundelein, IL” for directions to this entrance. ***If you are heading North on Interstate 94:*** Take the Hwy 176 exit and turn right at the foot of the ramp to head west (the ramp loops around). Continue on 176 to Route 45 and the entrance will be on your right at Dunbar/University street. ***If you are heading South on Interstate 94:*** Take Exit 10 for IL-21/Milwaukee Ave. Turn right on to Casey Rd and continue to U.S. Route 45. Turn left and continue on Route 45 until you reach the entrance at Dunbar/University Street. **All guests must park in the Purple Lot.**

For those traveling by air: Use O'Hare if possible. Chicago Northshore Limousine Group, Inc. can provide transportation from both airports to Mundelein and back. To use this service: *before you travel*, go to <https://allchicagonorthshoretransportation.hudsonltd.net/rwd?USERIDENTRY=holytrinity&LOGON=GO> and follow the directions for booking transportation, or call (800) 242-2657. If you call, you must say you are with the Society of the Holy Trinity to get the special rates (around \$90 one way from O'Hare). If you organize your own group then book together, your cost will be much less. For example, if two passengers coordinate in advance to ride together then make a reservation as “2” passengers, they can split the cost of a sedan. After claiming your luggage, call (800) 543-0037 to arrange pick-up. Remember, if you are making use of the car service, pay the driver directly. Do not bill St. Mary's or the Society. Air travelers can also arrange pick-ups with other STS members who are traveling by car by posting arrival times in the STS Facebook group. Others have taken the Metra train from the airports to Mundelein and then taken a cab the two miles from the station to St. Mary. Uber and Lyft are also possibilities. Individuals are responsible for arranging their travel to the campus.

Travel equalization: Members of the Society may be reimbursed up to \$500 for travel expenses exceeding \$175. You must book flights early to secure lower fares. Travel Equalization claim forms will be available at the retreat. Save your receipts to submit.
